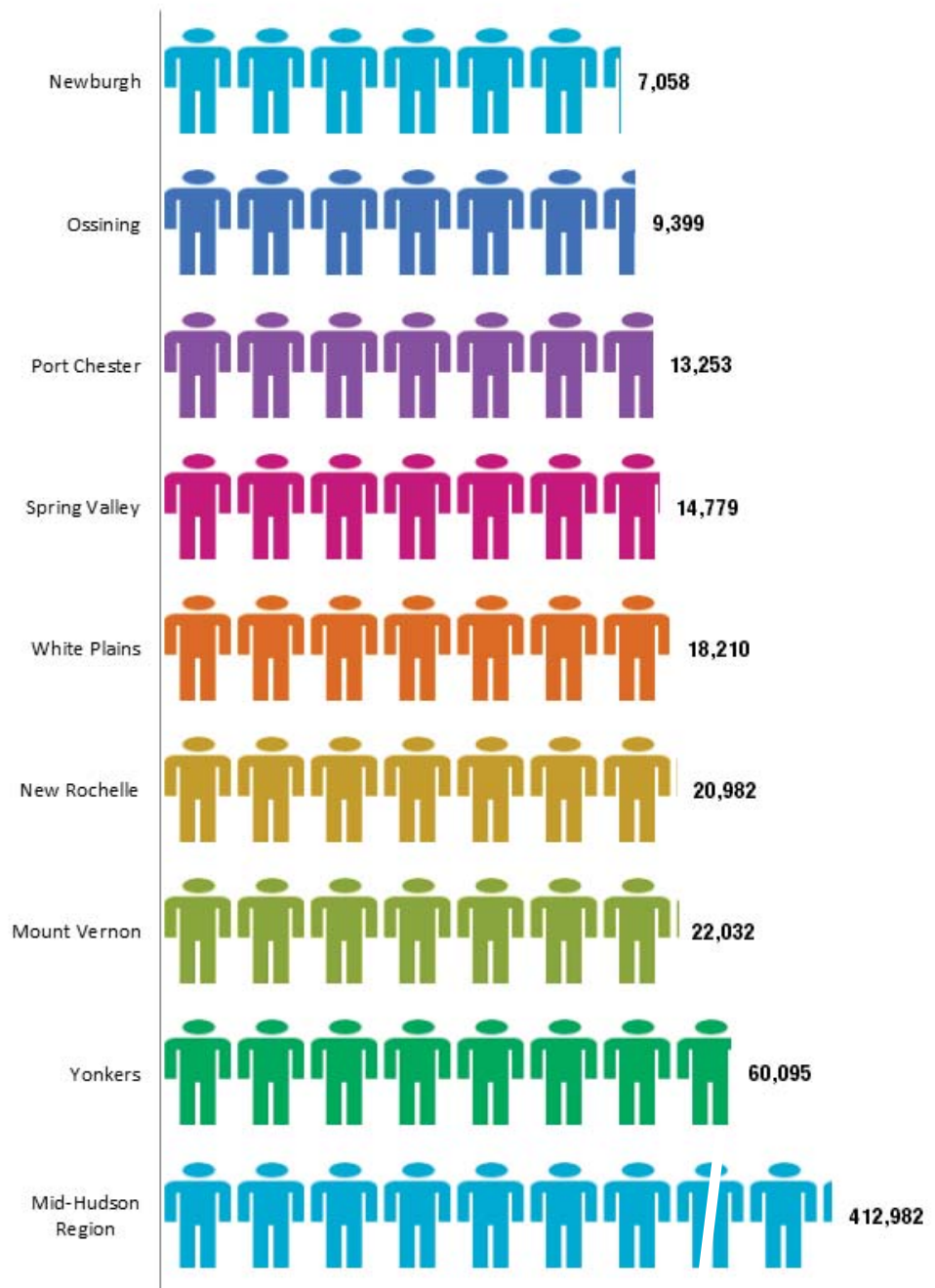

Top Mid-Hudson Cities with New American Population

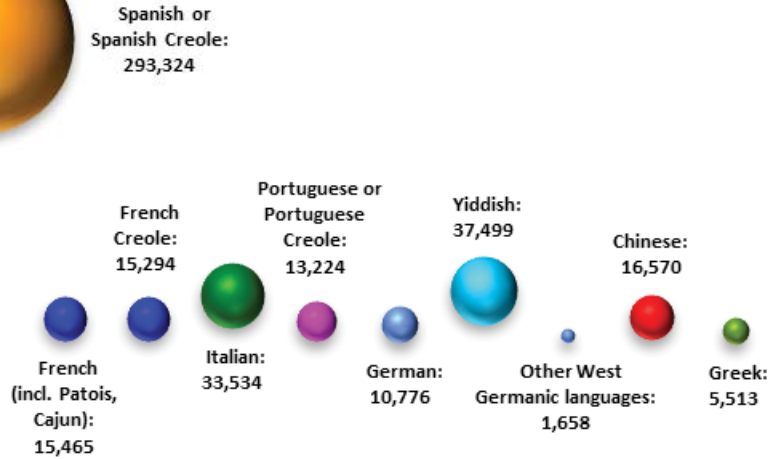

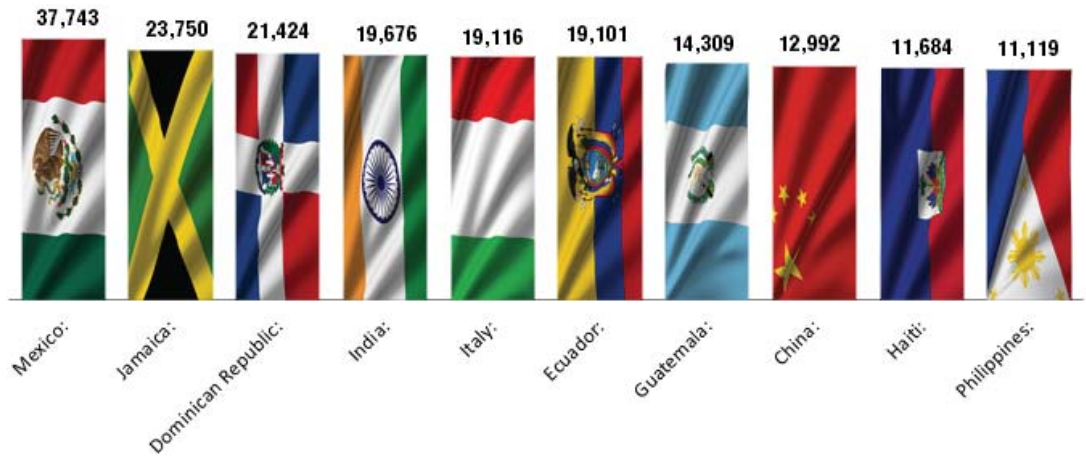
Top Foreign Languages Spoken in the Mid-Hudson

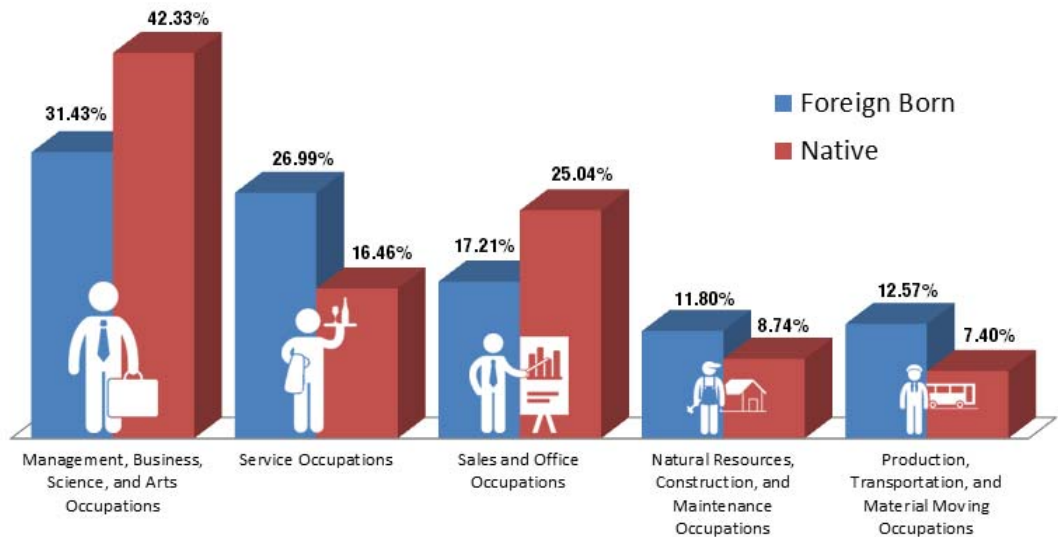
Top Countries of Origin of Mid-Hudson Foreign Born
