Top Southern Tier Cities with New American Population

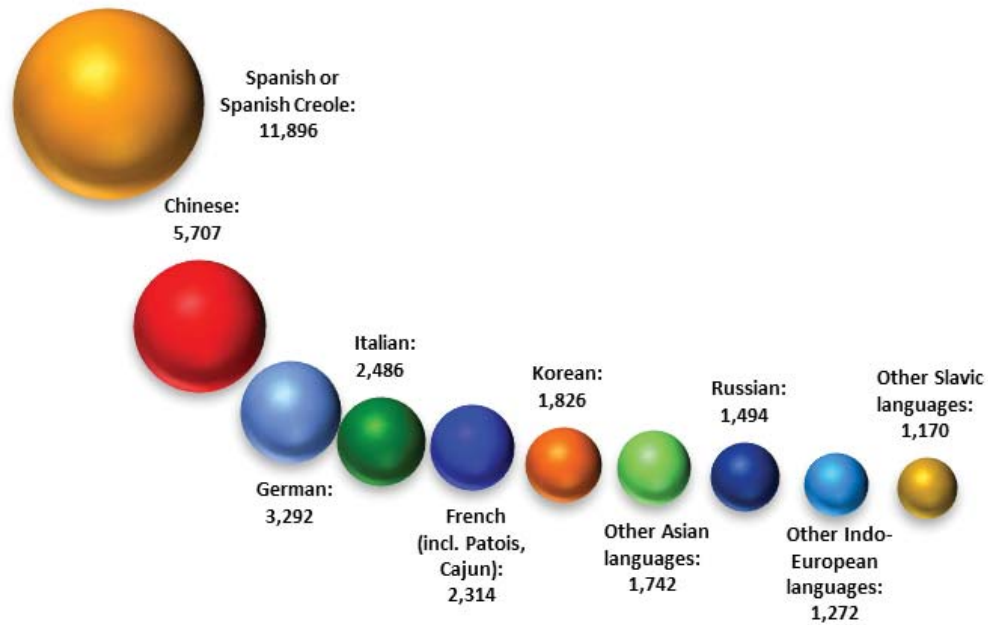

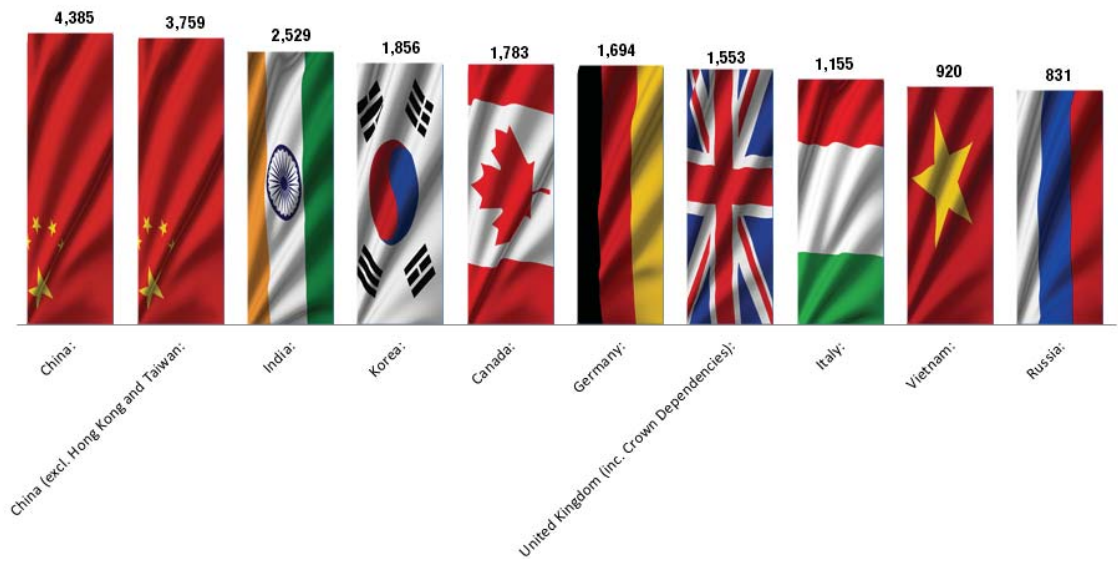
Top Foreign Languages Spoken in the Southern Tier

Top Countries of Origin of Southern Tier Foreign Born

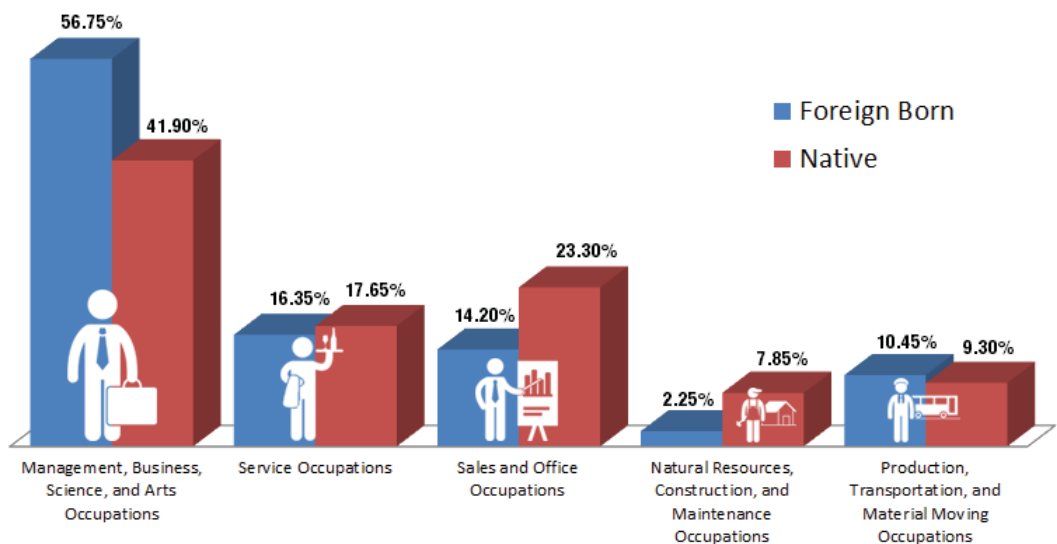
